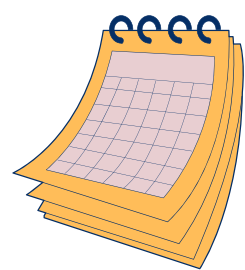
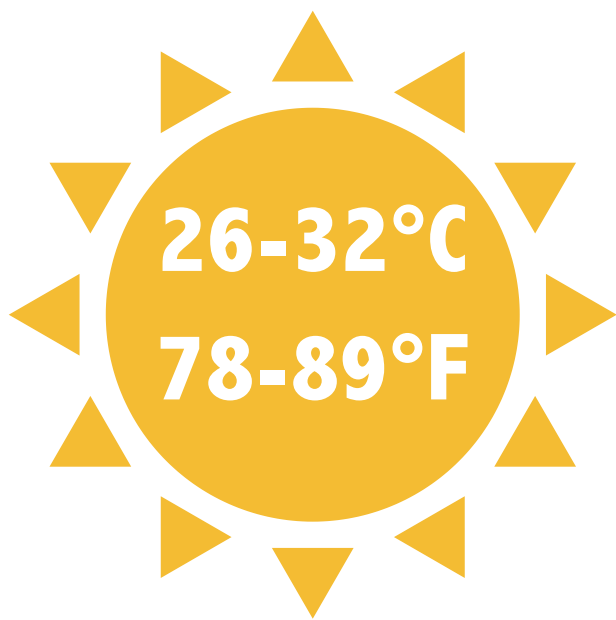

# HISTORY

## UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE SITE

*Port, Fortresses and Group of Monuments, Cartagena Situated in a bay in the Caribbean Sea, Cartagena has the most extensive fortifications in South America. A system of zones divides the city into three neighbourhoods: San Pedro, with the cathedral and many Andalusian-style palaces; San Diego, where merchants and the middle class lived; and Gethsemani, the 'popular quarter'.*

*The city is the sum of its incredible parts: its colonial, republican and modern architecture, its cultural festivals, outstanding gastronomic offerings, its unique hotel accommodation and tourism infrastructure; and its multiple non-traditional venues such as plazas, colonial mansions and fortifications that can only be described as one-of-a-kind.*
